El Segundo, which means “The Second” in Spanish, is one of the most productive mines in the Southwest because of its low overburden ratio.



El Segundo is located adjacent to Peabody’s Lee Ranch Mine and began production in 2008.



The mine has coal supply agreements with several Southwest electric utilities and co-ops and ships coal to its customers via the BNSF rail.

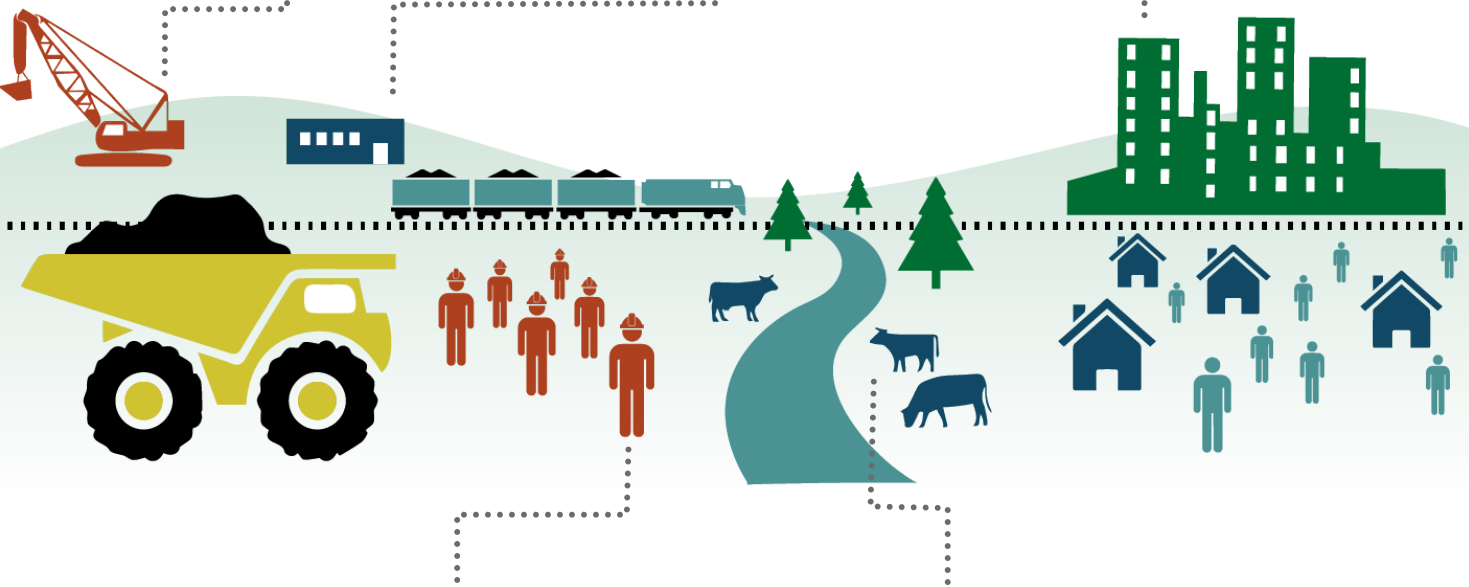
