The Wambo Complex consists of an open-cut and underground mine.



In 2014, Peabody agreed to establish an unincorporated joint venture project with Glencore to combine the existing operations of the Wambo Open-Cut Mine with the adjacent coal reserves of Glencore's United Mine.



JV operations are expected to commence in mid-2018, subject to regulatory and permitting approvals. Peabody expects the project to result in operational synergies.
