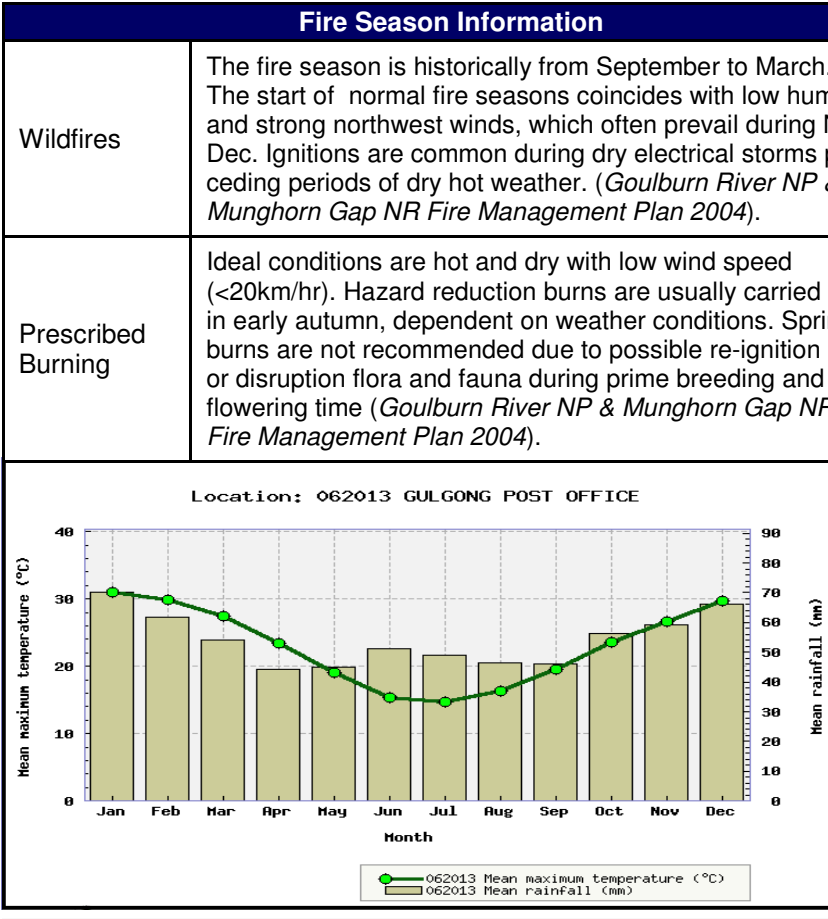
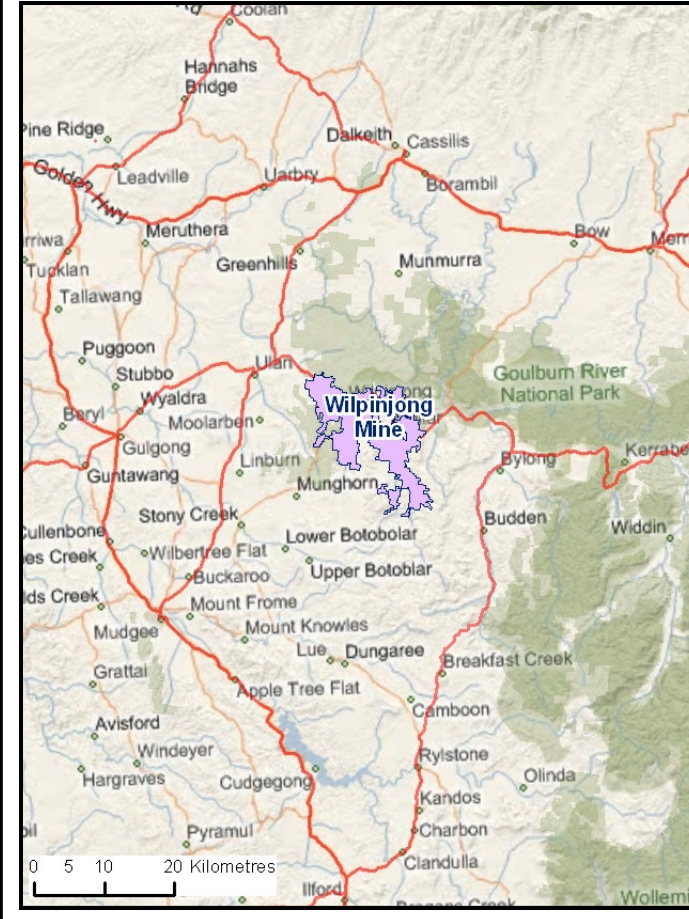

**RESTRICTED ACCESS**  
Access is not permitted to the Wilpinjong Coal Mine operations area unless approved by an authorised Wilpinjong Coal representative. Access through the operations area can only be provided by escort from an authorised Wilpinjong Coal representative. It is expected that any fires within this area will be contained by Wilpinjong Coal staff using available water trucks, dozers and graders.

Emergency Response

EMERGENCY RESPONSE – Wildfire

On discovery of a wildfire within or outside the mine boundary, the health and safety of all personnel is priority. Protect life, assess the situation from a safe position and raise the alarm, as first priority, then attempt to protect environment, property and assets, thereafter.

**Provide the following details**  
Your Name

Land Manager to assess the situation and likely or potential impacts for the site and operations or for neighbours

Land Manager to initiate response from internal and/or external resources (where appropriate)

Land Manager to notify Area Supervisor

Area Supervisor to implement emergency procedure if deemed appropriate (i.e. likely onsite impact)

Note: Keys for locked gates will be given by the Land Manager or Environmental Department

INTERNAL MINE OPERATIONS AREA RESPONSE

In the event of an emergency report the incident via two-way radio or telephone.

Using Mine Radio Channel '1'

or Using Cisco IP Phone Dial 2555 and wait for tone, then transmit over the radio.

or Dial the Emergency Telephone number:

Internal: 02 6370 2555 or External: 02 6370 2455

(If within OCE Dial: 0447 001 213 or 02 6370 2447)

During emergency transmissions all other two-way radio users shall remain silent until the Emergency Controller has advised that the emergency has ended or that radio silence has ceased.

State clearly "Emergency...Emergency...Emergency" then state:

Nature of the Emergency

Location of the Emergency

Detail what assistance is required

The Area Supervisor will implement the emergency procedure in accordance with this Emergency Response Manual (AM-WPJ-HS-MN-1202)

Post Emergency

1	Monitor the area until it is confirmed that the fire is extinguished
2	Debriefing of all personnel involved in the emergency
3	Full internal investigation
4	Continued support of injured personnel and their families
5	Restoration of facilities and equipment, and resumption of operations
6	Participate in any external investigation
7	Review the emergency response plan and upgrade as necessary
8	Document details of fire and append to implementation action plan
